Introduction

Key Focus Areas

Promoting Education

- Providing grants to a few schools and colleges in India for improving their infrastructure.
- Sponsoring books and uniforms for a large number of school-going children.

Health Care

- Supporting the cause of healthcare by making periodic donations to reputed organisations such as Shree Jain Medical Relief Society.

- To recommend the amount of expenditure for such projects/programmes.

Delivery Mechanism

KAIPL will undertake its CSR activities, approved by the CSR Committee, either directly or through the Bhanwari Kanwar Chordia Trust, the Khivraj Chordia trust, Khivraj Foundation or such other entity as approved by the CSR Committee.

The surplus, if any, arising out of the CSR activities, projects or programmes shall not form part of the business profit of the company.
